TITLE: Pensions Electronic Reporting System
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Introducing the Pensions Electronic Reporting System

The Superintendent of Pensions is implementing Web-Based Electronic filing for BC Registered pension plans under its Pensions Electronic Filing Initiative, with the goal of developing enhanced filing procedures for pension plan administrators and service providers.

What is the Pensions Electronic Reporting System?

The Pensions Electronic Reporting System is a web based tool which allows pension plan administrators to file their reports more efficiently to FICOM, through a secure web application.

This application will be available to administrators and service providers on September 8, 2009. Pension plans will be able to file their reports using this application by following this link;

Further, the Superintendent will no longer require pension plans with assets of under \$10 million to file custodial or unaudited financial statements with their annual pension reports. The Superintendent may however, request a plan to file additional reports where necessary.
