TITLE:	Amendments to Comply with Alberta Legislative Changes
LEGISLATION:	Alberta's <i>Employment Pension Plans Act</i>

PURPOSE

To confirm that pension plans registered with the British Columbia Superintendent of Pensions (the BC Superintendent) providing benefits to members employed in Alberta have until June 30, 2015 to file amendments needed to comply with changes to Alberta's *Employment Pension Plans Act* (EPPA).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The revised EPPA came into force effective September 1, 2014, and required that plans providing benefits to members employed in Alberta had until December 31, 2014, to file amendments needed to comply with the amended legislation.

The Alberta Superintendent of Pensions recently extended the deadline for filing of amendments to comply with the EPPA to June 30, 2015. The announcement may be found on the internet at <http://www.finance.alberta.ca/publications/pensions/pdf/update-1406.pdf>.

Plans registered with the BC Superintendent that provide benefits to members employed in Alberta will have until June 30, 2015 to file amendments needed to comply with the changes to the EPPA.
