**KAMLOOPS REAL ESTATE COMPANY SUSPENDED**

VANCOUVER – Assist Realty Ltd. has had its real estate licence suspended while an investigation continues into allegations that funds were handled in a way that contravened the Real Estate Act, B.C.'s superintendent of real estate, Alan Clark, announced today.

The Kamloops firm, which does business as Re/Max Assist Realty, is prohibited from selling real estate in British Columbia. The suspension order was issued Wednesday and may be appealed to the Commercial Appeals Commission.
